Motherhood is a blessing for most women, but when the disease of addiction prevents a woman from fulfilling her potential, the results can be devastating for both mother and child. Women who use alcohol or drugs during pregnancy often experience severe guilt and shame, on top of their stigmatized place in society, but their addiction is not a question of willpower.
